Combatting Tobacco

The International Pediatric Association fully endorses and supports the Framework Convention on Tobacco Control since it is represents a major step towards protecting child health. The IPA invites the National Pediatric Societies to take action to:

- improve the knowledge of pediatricians and other child health professionals about the health effects of tobacco smoking and of exposure to environmental tobacco smoke in children and adolescents, and to
- (commit to and) advocate for the implementation of the Framework Convention on Tobacco Control with emphasis on actions aimed at protecting children from tobacco from the prenatal period through adolescence.
